Baranski went on to earn her second Tony Award for her performance in Neil Simon's "Rumors." She also won an Emmy.

American Comedy and SAG Award for her performance in the hit series "Cybill," in addition to three subsequent Emmy Award nominations. Baranski received a total of 5 Emmy nominations for her guest roles on "Frasier" and "The Big Bang Theory."

Baranski has been nominated for four Critics' Choice Television Awards, as well as a Golden Globe nomination and TCA Award nomination, for her performance in the spinoff "The Good Fight."

Baranski can also be seen starring as "Agnes Van Rhijn" in the HBO series "The Gilded Age," from "Downton Abbey" creator Julian Fellowes. The critically-acclaimed series is an epic of the millionaire titans of New York City in the 1880s, and features an ensemble cast that includes Cynthia Nixon, Carrie Coon, Audra McDonald and Morgan Spector,

Baranski received an Honorary Doctorate from Juilliard, and in 2018, was inducted into the Theatre Hall of Fame.
